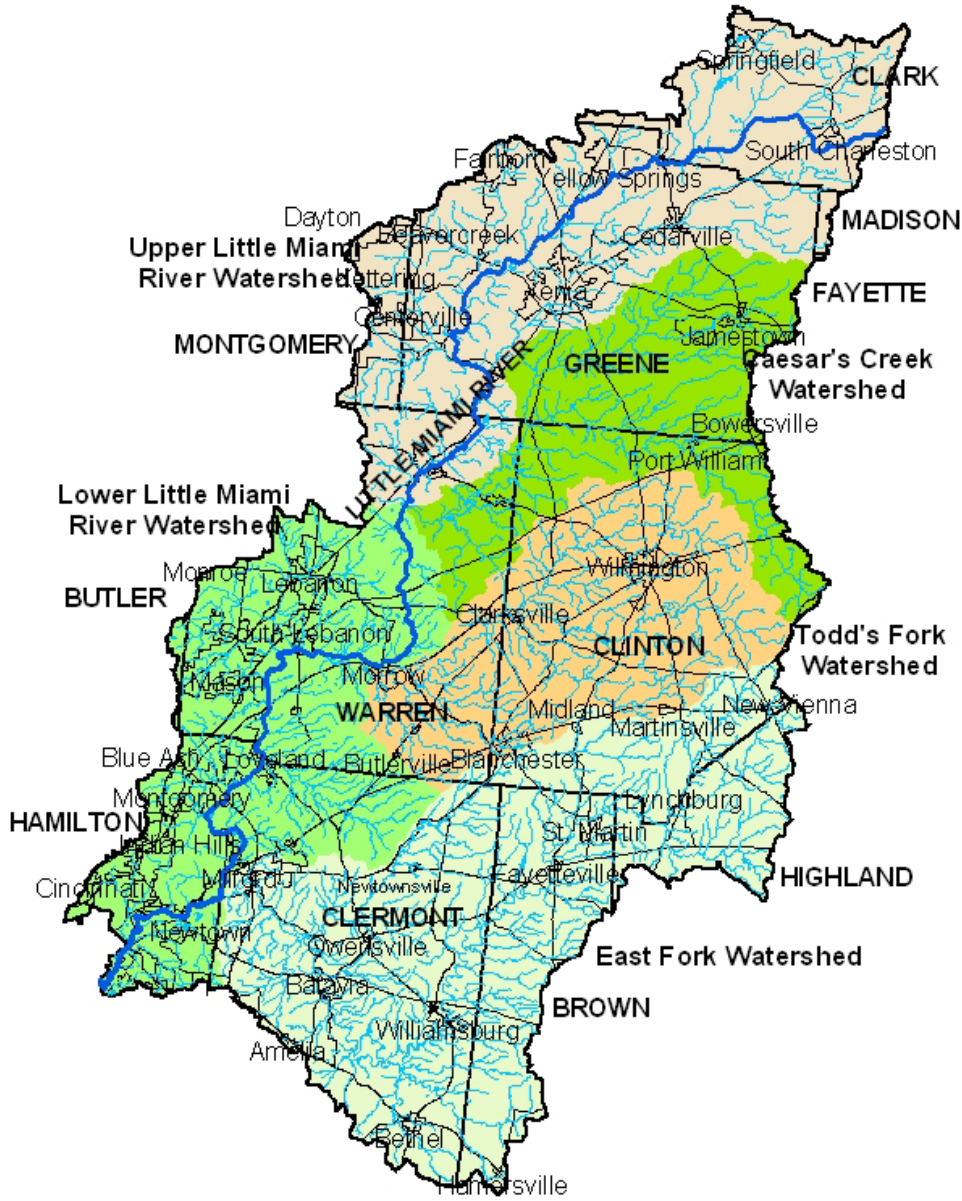

Rules for Submittal

1. All Photo's **MUST** include water in **SOME** form (liquid, ice, snow, clouds, rain, etc.) and **MUST** be taken within the **Little Miami River Watershed** boundaries (see map).
2. Submittal Fee: \$10.00 per image; Youth Status image submittals are FREE — All Contestants may only submit one image PER category.
3. Entrants will submit physical prints mounted on 1/8 – 1/4 inch foam core or similar backing material. Prints are to be a minimum of 8x10 inches or larger.
4. Prints must be labeled on the back as follows: Name, address, phone number, e-mail, status, category, location of photo, and any other shot information you would like to provide (where, when, context, situation).
5. All photographs should accurately reflect the subject matter and the scene as it appeared. Photos that have been digitally altered beyond standard optimization (removal of dust, cropping, adjustments to color and contrast, etc.) will be disqualified. Photos may be taken prior to the contest year or during it.
6. Prints are to be submitted by October 31st, 2007 (postmarked is acceptable), by 4 PM to: **Little Miami River Partnership, 777 Columbus Ave., Suite 5B, Lebanon, OH 45036**
7. Submission of a print conveys a non-exclusive license to LMRP to use the image for any display, publicity, public relations, educational, promotional use (such as a calendar) without further compensation to the copyright holder.
8. Award-winning prints will become the property of LMRP. Non-award winning prints may be picked up by the makers but will not be returned by LMRP; prints not picked up by January 1st, 2008 will become the property of LMRP.
9. Entrants retain ownership and all other rights to future use of their photographs. The LMRP shall have the right to verify, in their sole judgment, winner eligibility.
10. Previously published material for which non-exclusive rights were granted may be entered as long as you still warrant full rights. You must disclose when and where the photo appeared previously upon submission.

Statuses Open for Contest:

1. **Professional**: any experienced photographers who receive a significant part of their income from photography
2. **Amateur**: any beginning, amateur, or experienced photographers who do not receive a significant part of their income from photography
3. **Youth**: any photographer age 18 or under

Photographic Categories:

1. **Scenic** (NO sign of man)
2. **Recreational** (includes man or signs of man)
3. **Effects of Man** (includes a man-made problem)
4. **Black and White** (any subject)
